Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Extended Transition

As part of our commitment to ensuring that your child's transition from primary to secondary is as positive as possible, we are inviting you and your child to take part in our Extended Transition afternoon at 1.45-3.15pm on Friday 20th June 2025.

This is an optional session for students to meet one another and familiarise themselves with the school, prior to the main Transition days in June. The event will be hosted by myself and in attendance will be Mrs Lawrence (SEND/CO). It is an opportunity for you to meet key staff and address any queries you may have, as well as network with other parents/carers.

If after this session, any parent/carer feels that their child requires further bespoke visits prior to the Transition days or September, this can be arranged accordingly. Examples of additional visits include coming in to school at drop-off time to visualise the start of the school day, coming in to watch the end of the school day and/or coming in to observe lunchtimes. This can be discussed and arranged as needed, and of course any other visits bespoke to your child's needs can be arranged.

If you would like to attend, I would be most grateful if you could confirm this in writing by email to transition.enquiries@hurworth.nalp.org.uk and include your name and the name of your child. Alternatively, you may leave a message for me by phoning the main office. Please also advise of any dietary requirements as light refreshments will be provided. Primary schools are aware of this event, but you are responsible for informing them if your child is attending, and you are responsible for transportation to and from the event.

Please note that we are also holding a Y6 Information Evening in June (timings will be outlined in the letter regarding Transition days to be sent out shortly).
