Year 8	Etapa 6	<p>Where will you go this summer and what will you do during your holiday? Where would you go for your dream holiday and what would you do?</p>	
	Etapa 5	<p>Describe your diet (what you (usually) eat/drink/don't/never eat/don't/never drink/avoid and how often and why). Describe your daily routine. Say what activities you (usually) do to stay healthy. What did you do last week to be healthy? What are you going to do in the future to be healthy? What should we (not) do to be healthy?</p>	
	Etapa 4	<p>What did you do during the summer? Describe a past holiday (including your opinions with reasons). What is the town/country/place like? What can you do there? What is the best/worst thing about the town/country/place? What was the best/worst thing about your holiday?</p>	
Year 7	Etapa 3	<p>Where do you live? What is your house like? What is your opinion of it? What is your town like? What is your opinion of it? What do you do in your free time? What are you going to do in the summer?</p>	
	Etapa 2	<p>How many people are there in your family? Describe your family members (name/age/birthday/physical/personality). Describe your pets/ wild animal fact files (including which country they come from/ traits/ habitat). What is your school like? (What do you like/dislike and why?) Describe a typical school day. What is your opinion of your school subjects and why?</p>	
	Etapa 1	<p>How are you? And you? What is your name? How do you spell it? Where are you from? What is your nationality? How old are you? When is your birthday? What do you look like? What is your personality?</p>	

In each stage you have a set of Key Questions you will be able to answer accurately and fluently by the end of the stage. These key questions come from a range of topic areas and by studying these topic areas, your vocabulary range will develop.

For each stage, you will learn about the culture and geography of the Hispanic world. You will also learn specific language for real-life interactions on holidays e.g. hotel/restaurant etc
